I have been retained to represent the Township in the lawsuit filed by RD Michigan Property Owner I LLC et al. I have reviewed the lawsuit Complaint, the Township Zoning Ordinance, the Township Master Plan and the review by the Township's planning consultant Carlisle Wortman. I was also present at the public meeting on September 24, 2025.


I have recently received a proposed Consent Judgment from the attorney for the Plaintiff. This matter is time-sensitive and, accordingly, I would request that the Township Board schedule a special meeting so that I may discuss with the Board the provisions of the proposed Consent Judgment in a closed session.

Therefore, I would request that a special Township Board meeting be scheduled for either Tuesday, September 30, 2025, or Wednesday, October 1, 2025, so that myself along with Township Attorney Fred Lucas may discuss with the Township Board Members the proposed Consent Judgment in closed session. The Open Meetings Act, MCL 15.268, provides that a public body may meet in closed session "To consult with its attorney regarding trial or settlement strategy in connection with specific pending litigation." Thereafter, I would request that the Township Board go back into open session and vote on whether to approve or not to approve the proposed Consent Judgment.
