## **Regular Meeting September 10, 2025 Page 1 of 2**

1. The Regular Meeting of the Saline Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Marion on September 10, 2025, at 7:00 PM at the Saline Town Hall, 5731 Braun Road, Saline, MI 48176.
2. Members present: Supervisor Marion, Treasurer Zink, Clerk Marion, Trustee Hammond and Trustee D. Marion. Fifty-nine other citizens were present.
3. Trustee Tom Hammond led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Treasurer Zink moved, supported by Trustee Hammond that the agenda be approved as presented.
5. Trustee Hammond moved, supported by Trustee Marion that the consent agenda be approved as presented.
  - a. Approve minutes from the August 13<sup>th</sup> regular meeting.
  - b. Receive Clerk's budget, Financial Report
  - c. Approve accounts payable for September in the amount of \$19,339.42
  - d. Approve payroll for September in the amount of \$11,312.90
  - e. Approve payment to WCRC in the amount of \$60,401.30 for limestone project.
  - f. Approve accounts payable for June-July from expense card in the amount of \$752.97

Citizen Comments- The public had many questions and concern regarding the Data Center project: traffic, water usage/management of storm water, pollution, screening, effect on power usage, sound, cooling system and expansion of the project was among many of concerns. Residents also attended the meeting to express their view on being in favor the project.

  - e. Invenergy- a MOTION was made by Treasurer Zink and supported by Trustee Hammond to enter into the Host Community Host Agreement Ayes 5 Nays 0

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8. PA 116 Termination- a MOTION was made by Trustee Hammond and supported by Trustee Marion to table until the October Board meeting.
9. Trustee's Report- tree removal at cemeteries to start. October 7 a public hearing on the Event Barn ordinance. Fall cleanup September 13 8am- 1:55pm.
